Safety & Supervision

ACE will organise a guardian who will be there to advise your child on any issue that concerns them while they are away from home. Your child will meet with their guardian once a week and they talk on the telephone regularly.

Our wonderful homestay families offer a wealth of experience hosting international students and will make your child feel welcome and part of the family. Living with a real Ozzie (Australian) family will be a wonderful life changing experience for your child.

International Classes

ACE teachers will help your child to discover English and apply it to everyday situations. Students will expand their vocabulary, improve their grammar and most importantly, develop confidence in using spoken English every day. Your child will study with other international junior students in an English only environment which accelerates learning and enables lots of spoken interaction. Your child will also make friends from all over the world while studying English at ACE.
